
## What are we doing?

- We offer workplaces with or without a handicap and apprenticeships/vocational training for people with a handicap
- Areas in which we work include: Maintenance, cleaning, gardening, bicycle sales and repair (opened in May 2018), and customer interface/administration
- Our services have been certified CO<sub>2</sub>-neutral by Swiss Climate



Compensation: 48 t CO<sub>2</sub> per year are compensated by the purchase of certificates, sustainable management in the Swiss forest.

## Measuring: Carbon footprint



- Commuting, 21.5 t CO<sub>2</sub>
- Business travel, 11.2 t CO<sub>2</sub>
- Heating, 6.8 t CO<sub>2</sub>
- Waste, 3.1 t CO<sub>2</sub>
- Chemicals, 2.8 t CO<sub>2</sub>
- Garden tools\*, 1.0 t CO<sub>2</sub>
- Water, 0.5 t CO<sub>2</sub>
- Consumables, 0.5 t CO<sub>2</sub>
- Electricity consumption, 0.4 t CO<sub>2</sub>
- Paper, 0.3 t CO<sub>2</sub>
